To provide continuity for research, items are in agenda order although not necessarily discussed in that order.

3 - Approval of Agenda

Vice Mayor Terry Hamilton Wollin moved to approve the Agenda as presented. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.

4 - Approval of Minutes - August 29, 2012 meeting.

Mayor Lawrence moved to approve the minutes of the regular BIG-C (Barrier Islands Governmental Council) meeting of August 29, 2012, as submitted in written summation to each member. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.

5 - Approval of Treasurer's Reports for August 2012.

BIG-C Secretary/Treasurer Hamilton Wollin reviewed the August 2012 Treasurer's Report, stating the balance on August 31, 2012 was \$1,887.65.

Mayor Queen moved to accept the August 2012 Treasurer's Report. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.

6 - Correspondence:

Mayor Cretekos reported correspondence from a Tallahassee lobbyist soliciting business related to the BP oil spill. He suggested that similar firms reach out to individual cities.

Mayor Cretekos reported correspondence from the Florida Shore and Beach Preservation Society regarding resolution of regulations related to beach public access. He will provide them an update as additional information becomes available.

a) The Honorable Jeff Brandes, Florida House of Representatives

The Honorable Jeff Brandes said he was a candidate for the Florida Senate and reviewed his major issues of concern. He said he will meet with cities regarding their visions and offer help with them. He said he would put beach interests first if the topic of oil drilling is broached.

Discussion ensued with concerns expressed that some State amendments on the November ballot would reduce municipal revenues, making it more difficult to conduct business after cities already have cut services.

b) December Meeting Date

Discussion ensued regarding the BIG-C November/December 2012 meeting date.

Mayor Palladeno moved to schedule the BIG-C November/December 2012 meeting for December 5, 2012. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.

c) BIG-C PPC Appointment

PPC (Pinellas Planning Council) Interim Executive Director Michael Crawford said the PPC and MPO (Metropolitan Planning Organization) had relocated to the Courthouse and staff is moving forward with unification. The effective date of MPO/PPC unification is tied to MPO reapportionment. The Governor may wait until Spring 2013 to determine if Pinellas County will retain its single MPO.

Mr. Crawford discussed changes to board representation following unification. The beaches will have 1 seat on the 13-member Unified Board; currently beach communities have 2 seats on the 13-member PPC plus 1 seat on the 11-member MPO:

Mr. Crawford said terms for current PPC board members expire in December 2012 and require reappointments. He recommended the BIG-C consider continuity when determining representation. BIG-C members will report on their cities' recommended nominations.

Consensus was to accept nominations and appoint the BIG-C representative at the October 31, 2012 meeting.

9 - Miscellaneous:

BIG-C Representation on the TDC

It was stated that a new BIG-C representative needs to be appointed to the TDC (Tourist Development Council).

Mayor Lawrence moved to appoint Mayor Palladeno as the BIG-C representative to the TDC. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.

Commissioner Jim Parent moved to thank Mayor Lawrence for his service representing the BIG-C on the TDC. The motion was duly seconded and carried unanimously.
